

ICD-10 Exercises – MULTIPLE DIAGNOSIS CODES PER STATEMENT
(SEQUENCE COUNTS)

1. Severe sepsis with acute renal failure and acute respiratory failure
2. Early alzheimers progresses to combative behavior
3. Patient with hepatitis B seen in clinic – complains of joint pain, loss of appetite, nausea and vomiting and weakness and fatigue. Admitted for severe dehydration.
4. Obstetrical patient in 3rd trimester admitted for pneumocystis carinii pneumonia due to AIDS.
5. Lung abscess due to MRSA
6. Patient presents for HIV screening due to risk factors
7. Follow-up exam to reconstructive surgery – hypospadias repair
8. Initial encounter, 45 y.o. woman receiving first cycle of chemotherapy for pancreatic cancer seen in the emergency department for severe nausea and vomiting due to chemotherapy-induced dehydration
9. Outpatient clinic visit – ascites due to disseminated malignant neoplasm
10. Hypertensive heart disease with congestive heart failure
11. Cellulites, left lower leg. Type 2 diabetic, on oral medication. Cellulitis elevates blood glucose and physician treating with sliding scale insulin regime.
12. 62 y.o. man admitted through ED, diagnosed with transmural Q wave infarction. Has ASHD and pacemaker placed 5 years ago.
13. Patient consultation – high risk obstetrician. Two months pregnant and diagnosed with malignant neoplasm, left breast.
14. Initial encounter for a patient with sepsis due to a blood transfusion. Has hemophilia.
15. Anemia due to prostate cancer
16. Admitted for chemotherapy due to primary liver cancer
17. admitted with bowel obstruction. Also has hypertensive Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) Stage V
18. Return visit to oncologist, metastatic cancer right axillary lymph nodes. History of right upper-outer quadrant breast cancer, still in treatment.
19. Brain biopsy report – secondary cancer from primary site of the breast. Mastectomy 5 years ago, no current treatment to primary cancer.
